What happens after you register?

This is a confidential service. Your contact person will give your name and address confidentially to the central registry for the Hamper Campaign.

After this is done, names and addresses will be checked for duplication.

Your contact person will call you to tell you the date and the approximate time of delivery. **We ask that you be home to receive your hamper.** It will be delivered to you by a team of volunteers. If you are not home, it will be returned.



What about the rest of the year?
