What happens after you register?

This is a confidential service. Your contact person will give your name and address confidentially to the central registry for the Hamper Campaign. After this is done, we will check names and addresses for any duplications.

You will receive a letter that confirms your address for us, and to let you know about how you will get your hamper. Due to COVID-19, there will be changes in the way things usually work, because our volunteers must follow all prevention guidelines set out by public health authorities.
